

**9-1-1 Transcript – Call from Sherry Stewart 1/29/10**

OPERATOR: 911

CALLER: Uh, yes, I need for the police to go out and do a welfare check on my niece. Her boyfriend is real suicidal. He done already tried to kill hisself . . .

OPERATOR: Okay.

CALLER: and now we can't get no contact from her.

OPERATOR: Okay. Ma'am, ma'am, what's the address please?

CALLER: Um, she lives . . . I don't know the exact address. It's 125<sup>th</sup> and Sandy, it's the Sandy Terrace Apartments.

OPERATOR: The Sandy Terrace?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: And what apartment number?

CALLER: 37.

OPERATOR: Number 37?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: Okay, that's about 128<sup>th</sup> and Sandy, right?

CALLER: Right, some where in there.

OPERATOR: What's your name please?

CALLER: My name is Sherry.

OPERATOR: What's your last name Sherry?

CALLER: Stewart.

OPERATOR: Stewart?

CALLER: Yes, and her name is Angie Jones.

OPERATOR: Okay and Sherry, where are you calling from?

CALLER: I'm calling from 162<sup>nd</sup> and Stark.

OPERATOR: What's your phone number please Sherry?

CALLER: 503-847-0697.

OPERATOR: 503-847-0697?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: And we're going to be checking on . . .? Her name again is . . .?

CALLER: Angie. And can I also tell you just proceed with caution. Because he already wants the police to kill him. His brother just died this morning, so that's where his mind is. And he wants the police to kill him.

OPERATOR: Okay, okay, what was Angie's last name?

CALLER: Jones.

OPERATOR: Jones?

CALLER: Uh huh.

OPERATOR: And how old is Angie?

CALLER: Angie is 23.

OPERATOR: Is she a female, white, black, Hispanic, Asian?

CALLER: Black.

OPERATOR: And uh,

CALLER: (unintelligible)

OPERATOR: And there's three kids with her?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: And it's her boyfriend that's suicidal?

CALLER: Yes. It's her older kids' daddy. It's her two older kids' father, his name is Aaron Campbell.

OPERATOR: Is he supposed to be there?

CALLER: No.

OPERATOR: Okay. So, do you think he did something with her?

CALLER: I do, because he's already tried to . . . when she called me earlier she said he had put the gun to his head but the gun wouldn't fire. The four times he tried to shoot himself and it wouldn't fire. And when he shot up in the air, then it went off. He left and why she let him back in, I don't know. But ever since she let him back in, nobody has heard from her. Her mom . . .

OPERATOR: How long has it been since you've heard from her?

CALLER: Uh, it's been, it's been over an hour now.

OPERATOR: What is her phone number?

CALLER: Her phone, let me look it up. I got to look on my phone to get her number.

OPERATOR: That's okay, go ahead.

CALLER: Okay. It's 503-367- uh, 0-3-6-5.

OPERATOR: So, that was about an hour ago he did this?

CALLER: Yeah, this has been going on all this morning. He's just . . .

OPERATOR: Okay, but with the gun that you just told me, was that about an hour ago?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: Okay.

CALLER: And nobody has had contact with her since.

OPERATOR: Okay, now I'm getting the police started while we're talking. You want, you say he wants, he wants possibly to do suicide by police?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: Okay, what is his name?

CALLER: Aaron Campbell.

OPERATOR: Do you know his date of birth or how old he is?

CALLER: Uh, Aaron is probably, I don't know, 25, 26 . . .

OPERATOR: Is he white, black, Hispanic, Asian?

CALLER: Black.

OPERATOR: He's about 26, about how tall?

CALLER: Uh, I'd say, probably like 5-6; 5-7.

OPERATOR: Heavy or medium build?

CALLER: Uh, medium.

OPERATOR: What's his hair like?

CALLER: Um, last time I seen him it was braids, I haven't seen him in quite some time so . . . but he used to have like maybe shoulder length hair. I don't know if it's still braided or if he still has that much hair or not.

OPERATOR: Do you know what kind of weapon he was armed with?

CALLER: Uh, no, she didn't even say.

OPERATOR: Okay, this information came from your daughter, is that correct?

CALLER: Uh, niece.

OPERATOR: Or your niece is it?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: Yeah.

CALLER: Yes, because when he came back when I was talking to her, she immediately got off the phone and texted me and was like he's back, I got to call you later and I haven't heard from her since.

OPERATOR: Okay. All right, does he drive a vehicle?

CALLER: Yes, but I don't know what kind of car he has.

OPERATOR: So he had a brother that was, that died this morning?

CALLER: Yes.

OPERATOR: And, you got all this information from your, uh, it came from your, from your niece?

CALLER: Yeah, well, we knew about the brother that was about to pass, cause he had heart problems. But yeah, the information that I'm giving you about the gun, the suicide, that all came from her.

OPERATOR: In a text?

CALLER: No, we was talking on the phone. He wasn't there when I first talked to her but then when he came back, she hung up on me and then texted me and said he was back and she couldn't talk to me, she had to call me back later. Well, I sat here and thought about it for a minute and I'm like, no, that's not okay and so I've been calling her ever since then and . . .

OPERATOR: Right.

CALLER: . . . and she won't answer and I like texted her and said I'm gonna send the police if you don't call me and she still hasn't.

OPERATOR: All righty. Uh, we've got police on the way.

CALLER: Okay.

OPERATOR: And we should be there shortly, okay?

CALLER: All right. Thank you so much.

OPERATOR: All right, thank you Sherry.
