Re: Petition seeking records from Portland Community College

Dear Ms. Wright:


On April 19, 2022 this office received a petition from you alleging that Portland Community College (PCC) denied your public records request for: “Business Administration SWRFFTE Fall 2022 - The Banner report SWRFFTE provides a list of all instructors teaching classes in Business Administration. SWRFFTE also shows instructor workload – including overload and non-instructional workload such as Faculty Release by course workload by campus, course number, and course registration number. Parameter: All campuses, Term Fall 2022 Parameter: Business Administration All District Instructors.” Specifically, although PCC provided you data in response to your request, you cite multiple inaccuracies or inconsistencies in the data it produced as to a particular instructor (Wilson Nitunga) and request that we compel PCC to provide you with accurate information.

For purpose of this petition I will assume that, as you allege, the data PCC provided is in fact inaccurate as to this instructor. This office does not have the jurisdiction to compel a public body to keep complete and accurate records nor may we evaluate the factual accuracy of data turned over in response to a public records request.

As such, the petition is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
