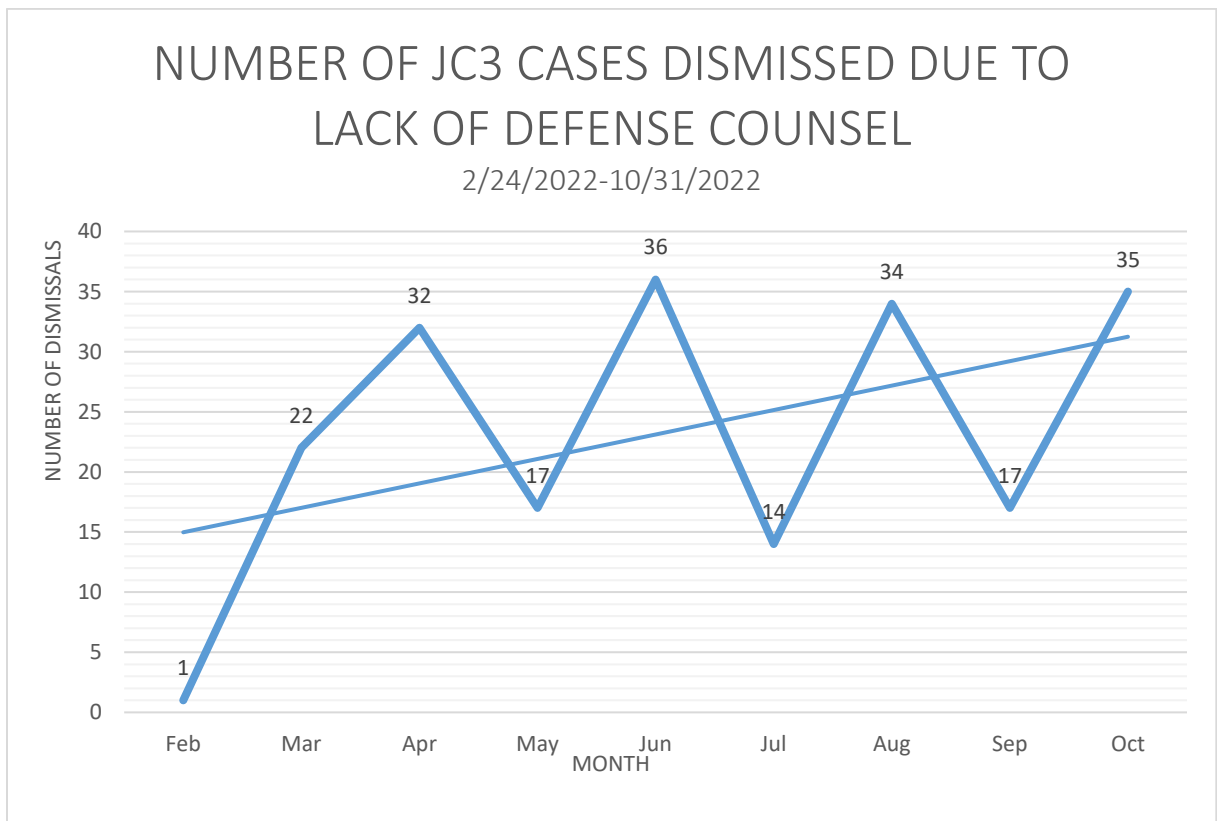


JC3 Felony Arraignments: Dismissals Due to Lack of Counsel

1. Between 2/24/22 and 10/31/22, the court **dismissed a total of 285 felony and misdemeanor cases. 180 of these cases were dismissed after being set over one or more times.**

Excluding hearing involving a defendant's failure to appear (FTA), there were **2,223 hearings that resulted in a set over due to lack of defense**; 2,428 total felony hearings have been impacted by lack of counsel when including hearings that resulted in dismissal. Hearings with FTAs are excluded because only some, not all, are affiliated with cases impacted by lack of counsel, and would result in a high degree of uncontrolled error if included (e.g. it is unknown which cases involving FTA had counsel or not).

2. Cases dismissed per month, February through October 2022

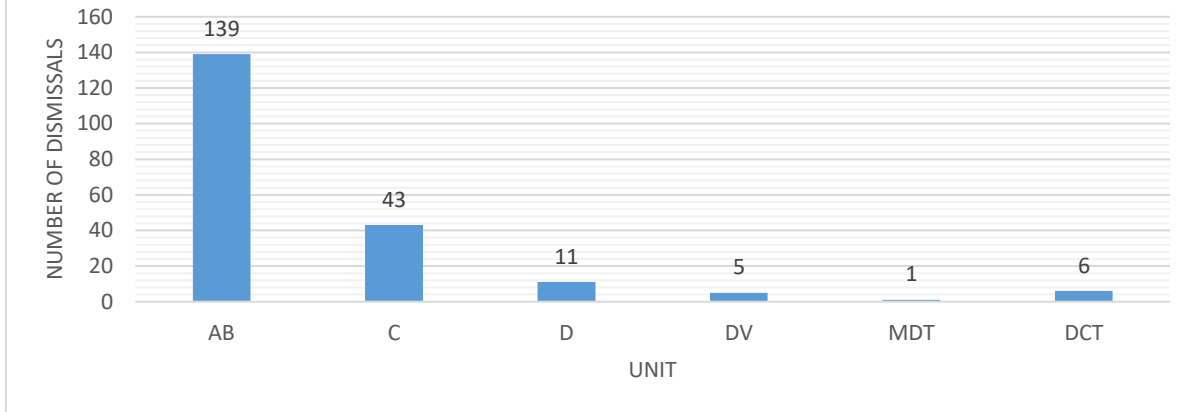


3. Cases broken down by unit

Definitions:

JC 3: Felony arraignments and hearings.

A/B Unit: This unit prosecutes a variety of felonies including property crimes, traffic offenses, human trafficking offenses, and all forms of overdose prosecutions.

Unit C: This unit prosecutes major felonies, serious vehicular crimes and gang-related offenses.

Unit D: This unit prosecutes all felony physical assault cases that are not domestic violence in nature, gang related or reckless vehicular assaults.

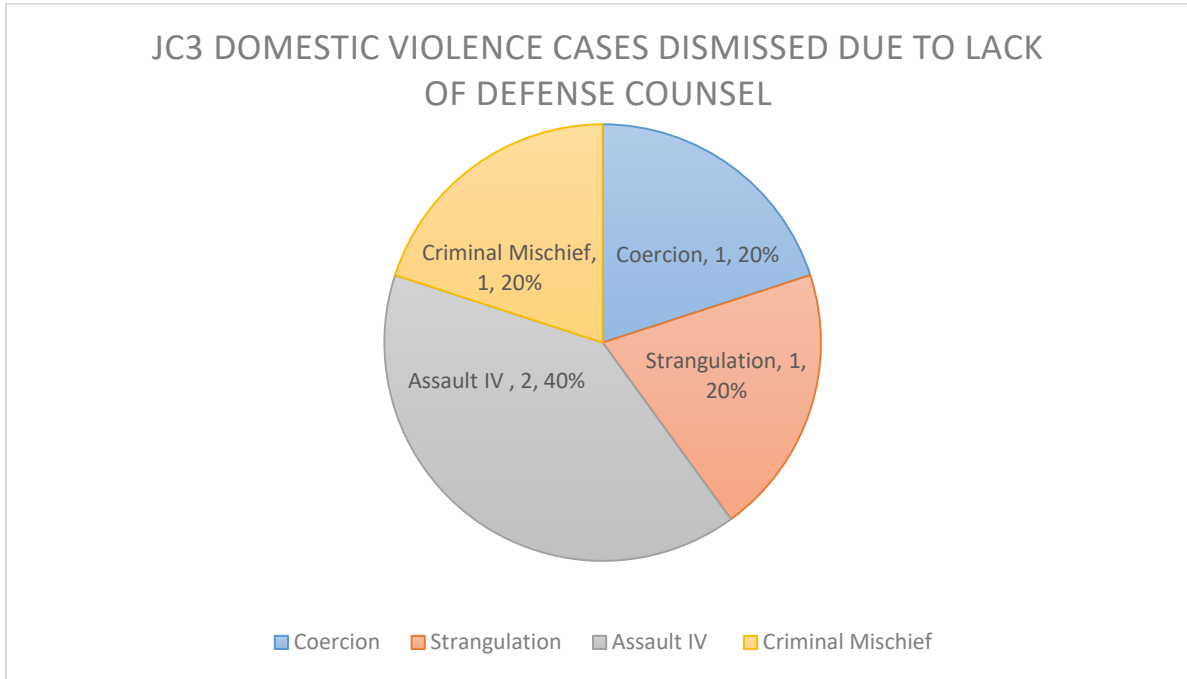
DV Unit: This unit prosecutes all crimes of domestic violence between family or household members as defined in ORS 135.240(4).

MDT: The Multi-Disciplinary Teams unit prosecutes child abuse.

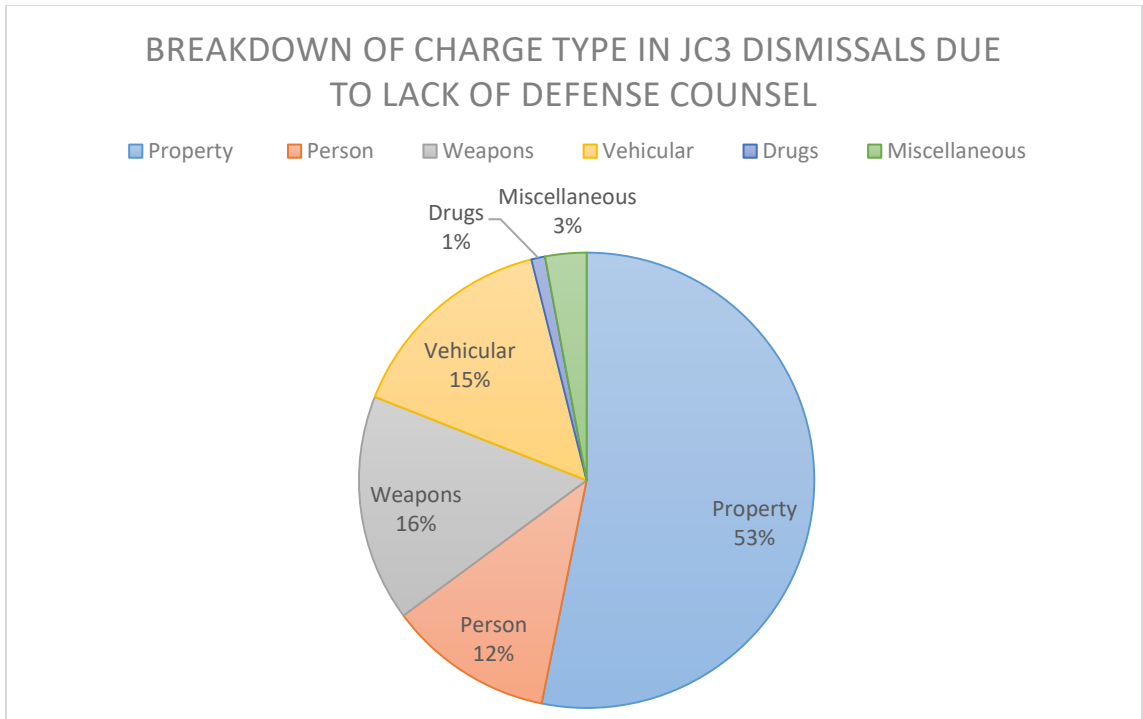
DCT (District Court Trial): This refers to misdemeanors that accompanied felonies as a lesser charge.

4. DV cases by primary charge



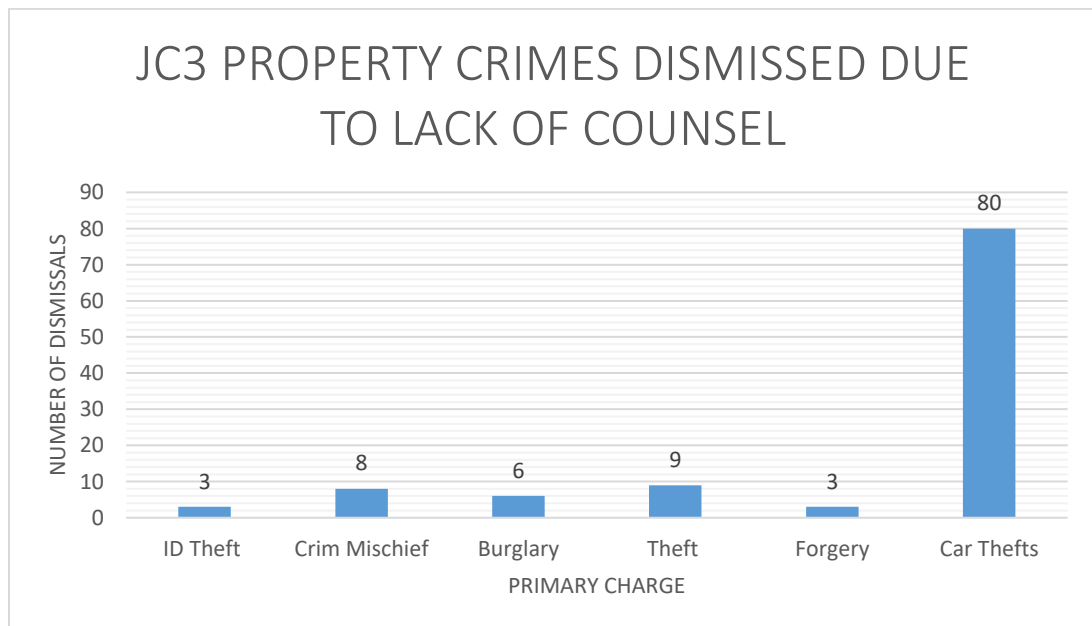
5. Crime types by primary charge (person, property, weapons, vehicular, drugs, miscellaneous) for all dismissals

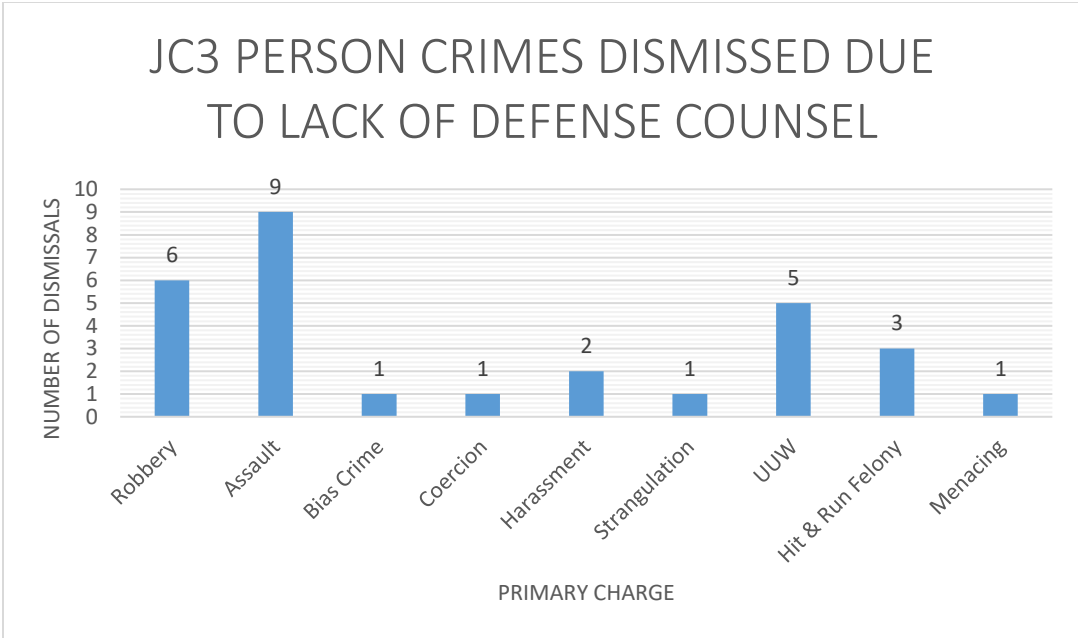
6. Dismissed case types broken down by primary charge:

a. Property crime (ID Theft, Theft, Criminal Mischief, Burglary, etc.)

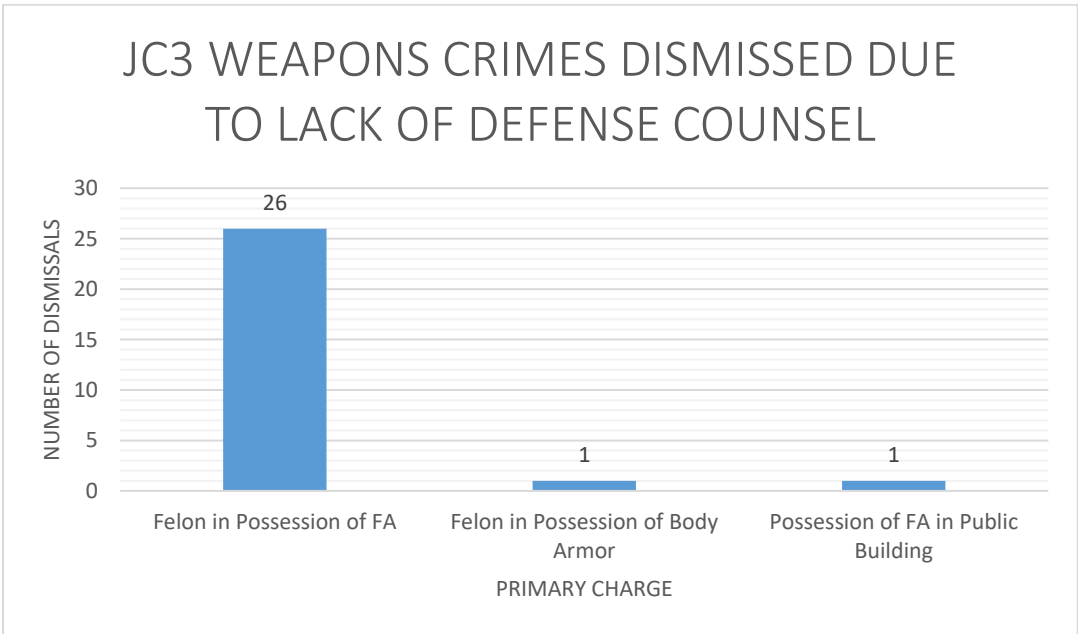

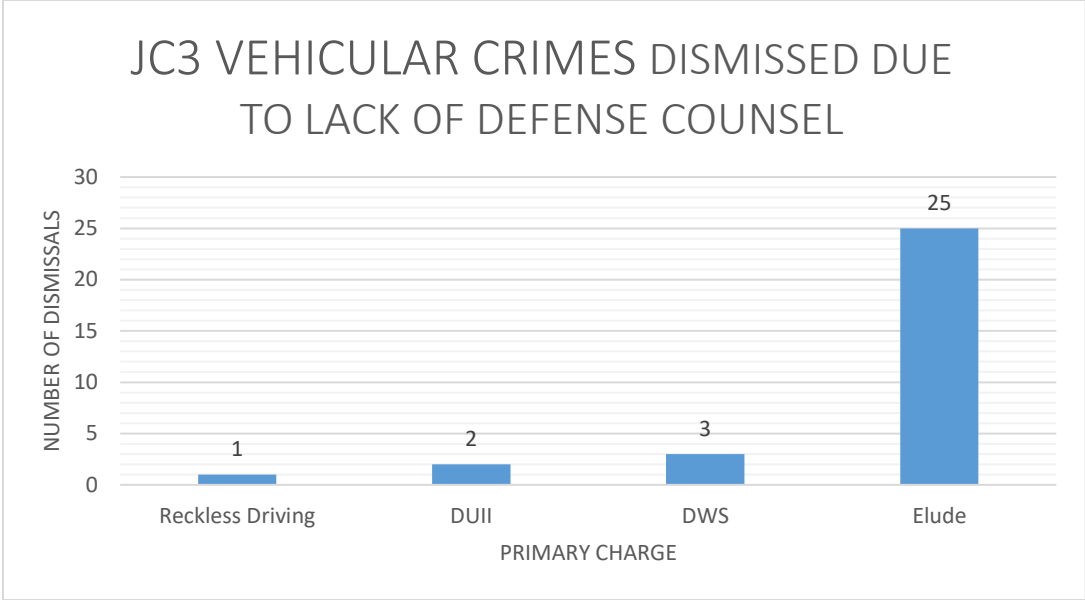


c. Weapons offenses (UPF, FPFA)

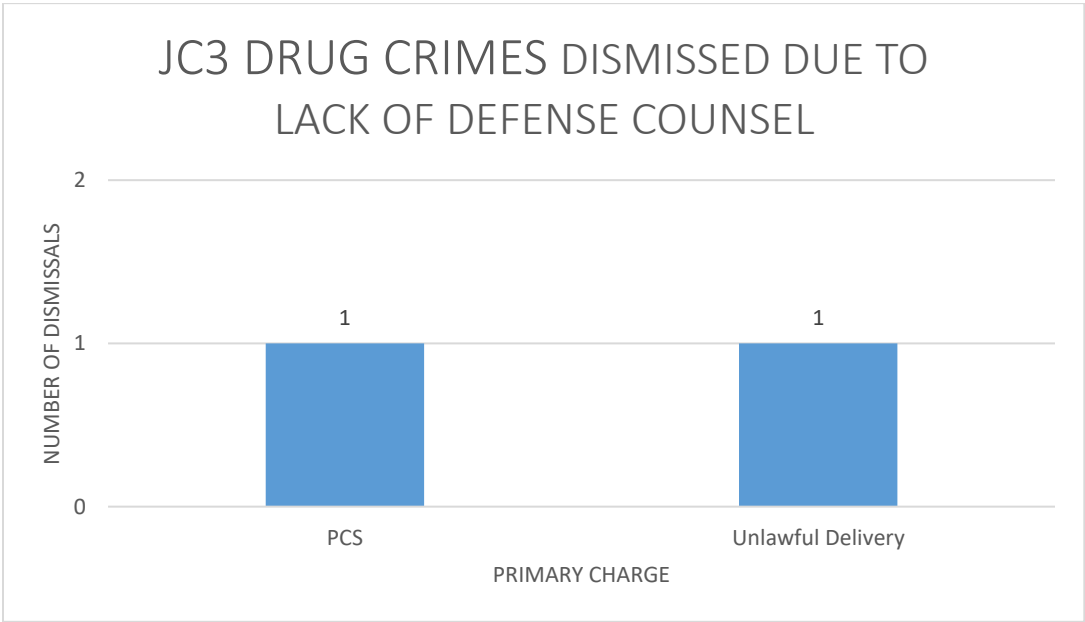


d. Vehicular crimes (DUII, Felony Elude, DWS, PSV, UUUV, etc.)

*with an acknowledged error of +/- 2 cases (.01%)

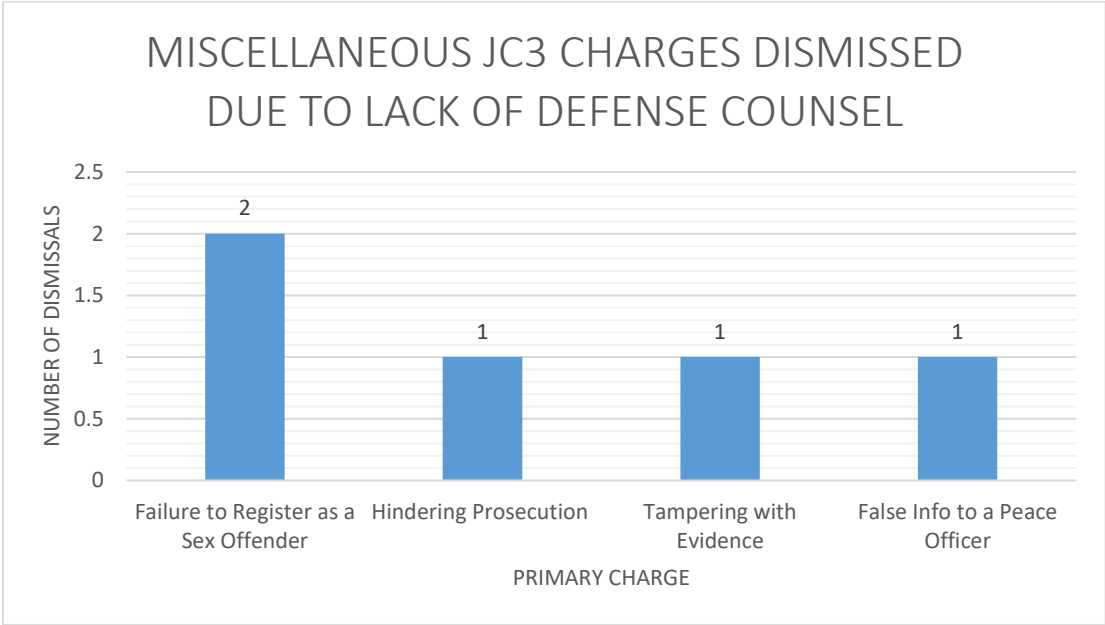


e. Drugs (PCS, Unlawful Delivery)

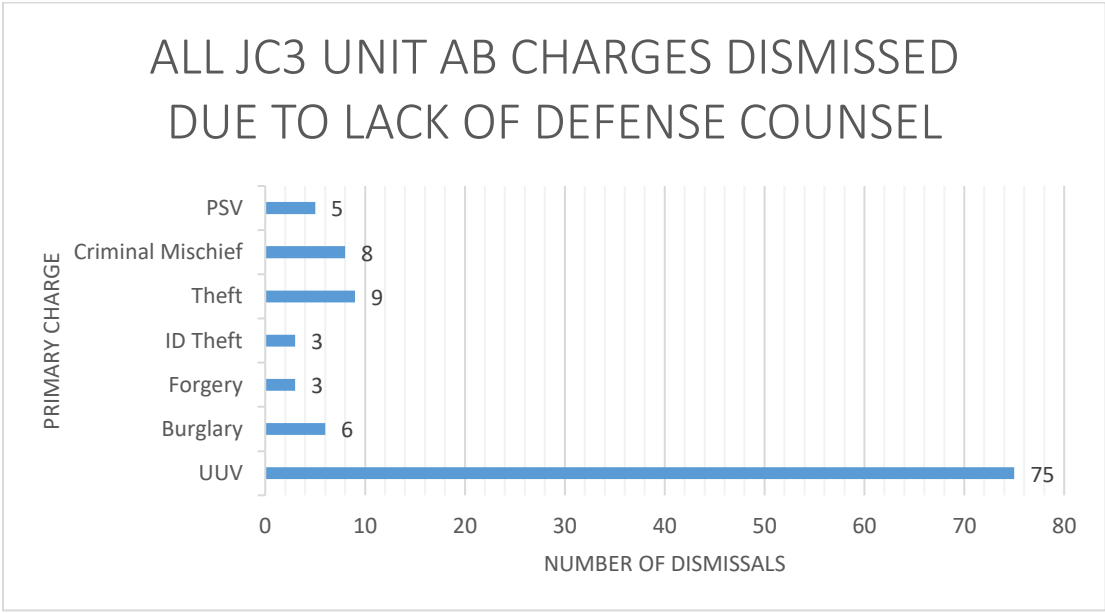


f. Miscellaneous (False info to Peace Officer, Failure to Register, Hindering, Tampering, etc.)
