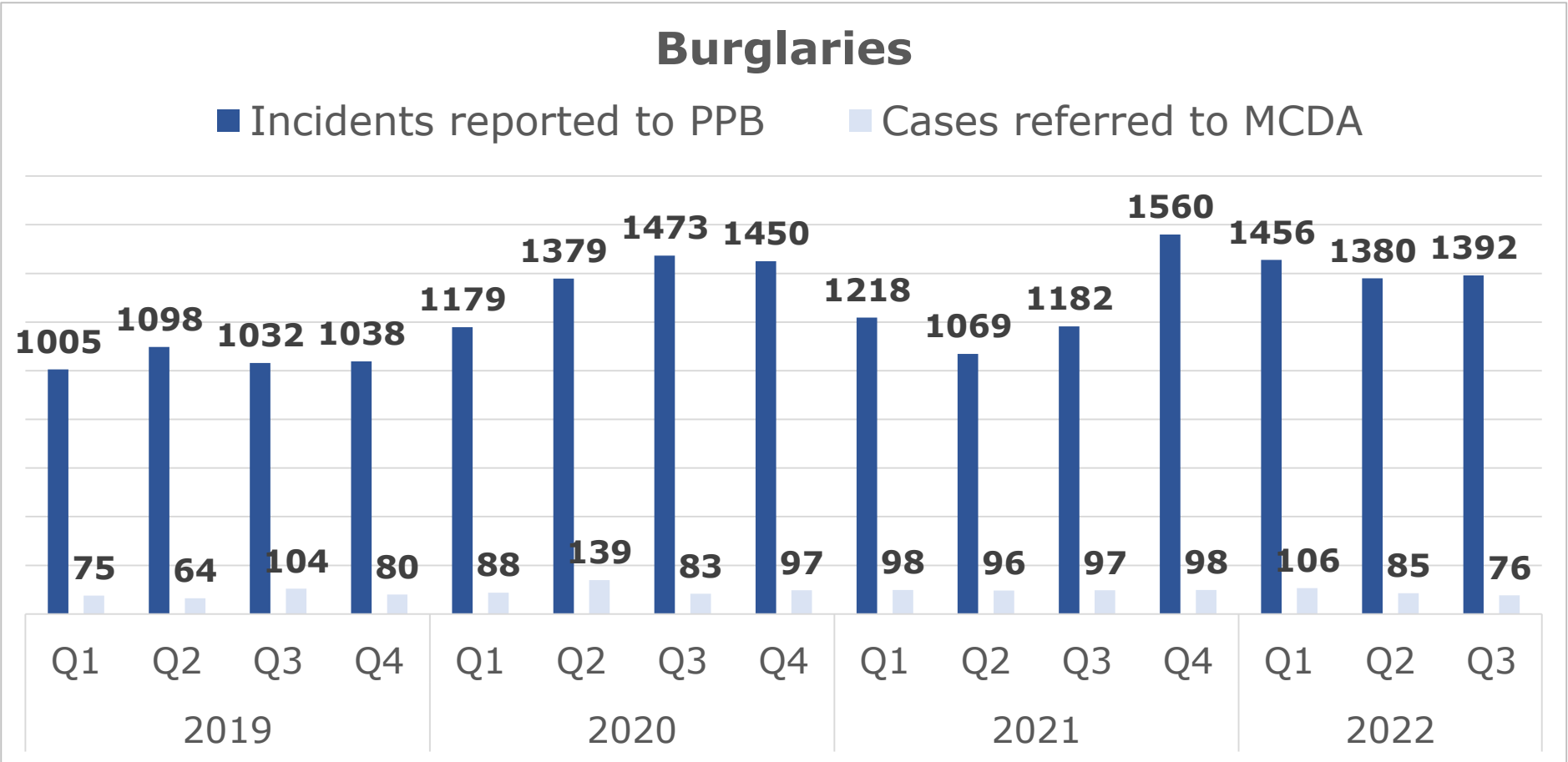
Quarterly reported incidents, referred cases, clearance rates, and issuance rates

# Sources and definitions

- Sources
  - Reported incidents data come from Portland Police Bureau Open Data website (<https://www.portland.gov/police/open-data>)
  - Referred case counts and case issuance rates come from the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office's internal CRIMES database
  - Clearance rates are calculated by dividing the number of incidents reported to PPB in a given quarter by the number of the cases referred to MCDA with incident dates from that given quarter
    - These calculations do not account for repeat offenders or cases where arrest does not lead to an MCDA referral; given this noise in the data, clearance rate data is most useful for identifying trends
- Definitions
  - "Burglary cases" are cases involving at least one referred Burglary I or II charge
  - "Robbery cases" are cases involving at least one referred Robbery I, II, or III charge
  - "Motor vehicle theft cases" are cases involving at least one referred Unlawful Use of a Vehicle or Possession of a Stolen Vehicle charge
  - "Theft cases" are cases involving at least one referred Theft I, II, or III charge
  - "Criminal mischief cases" are cases involving at least one referred Criminal Mischief I, II, or III charge

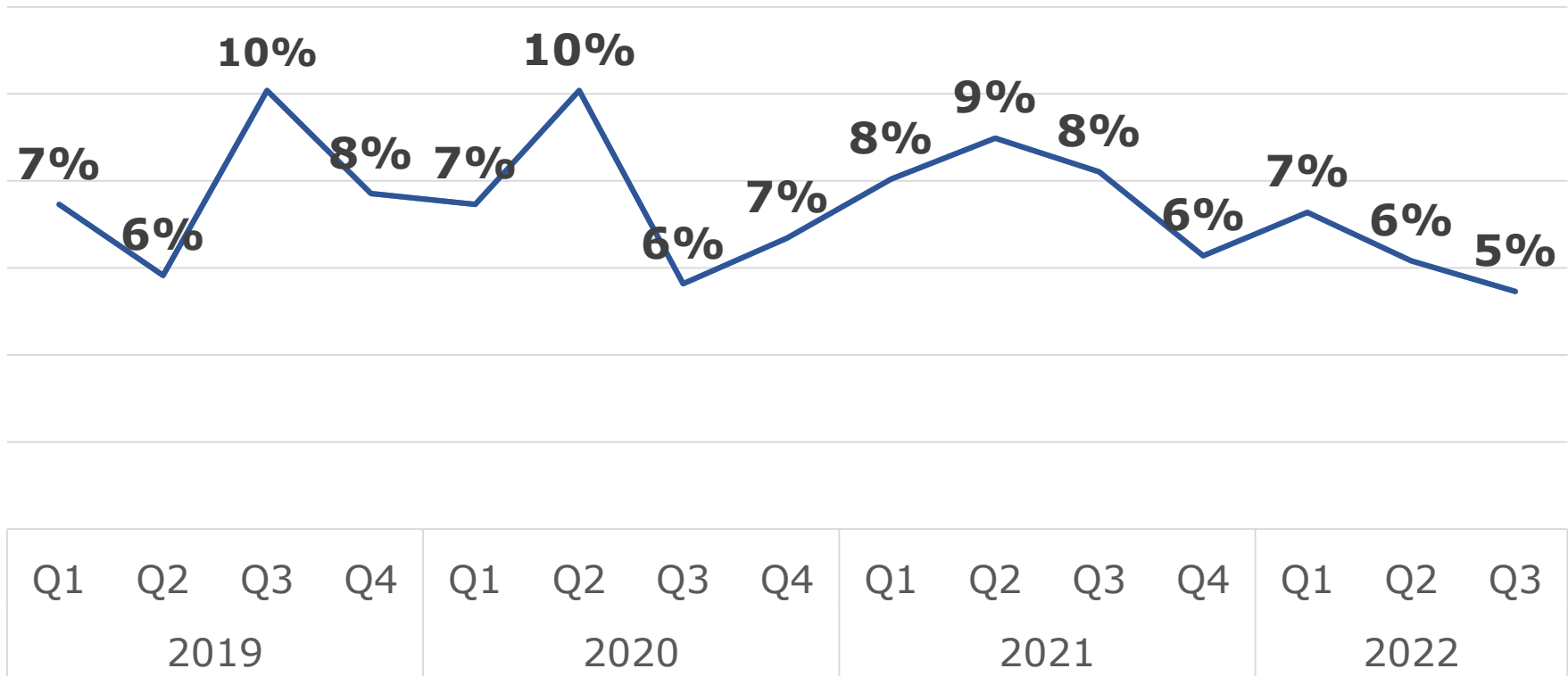

# Burglaries reported vs. burglary cases referred for prosecution



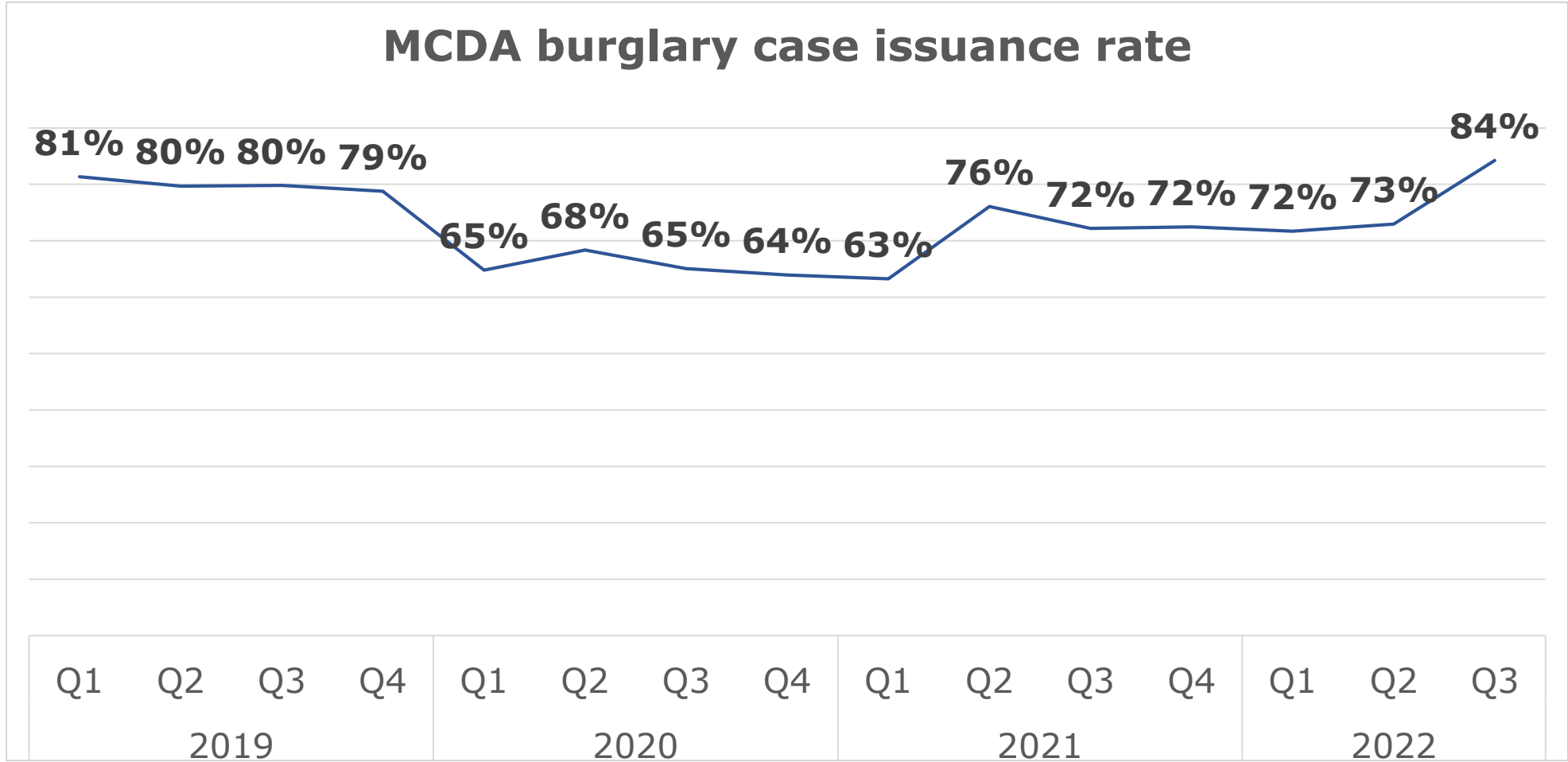
# Burglary clearance rate

**Percent of burglaries reported to PPB resulting in cases referred to MCDA**



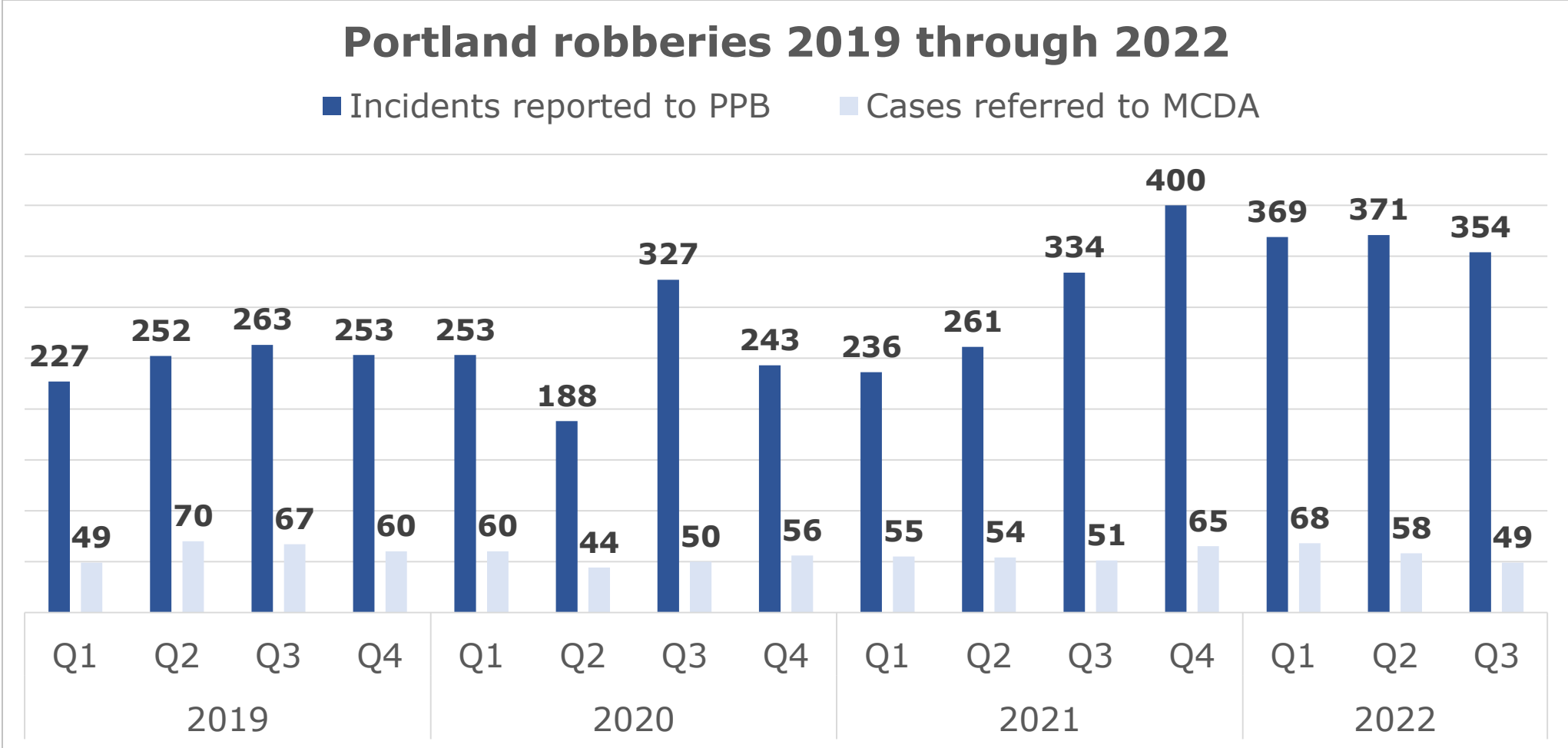
# Burglary prosecution rate

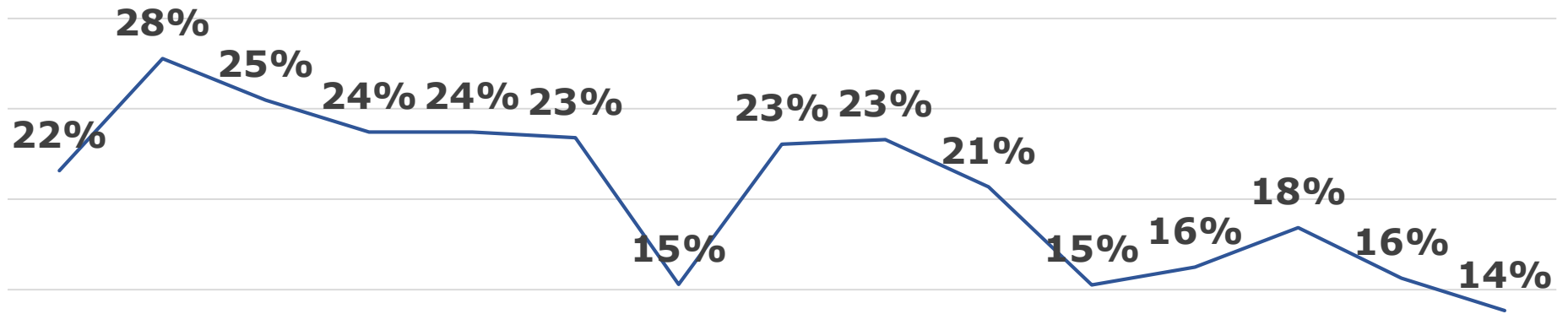
# Robberies reported vs. robbery cases referred for prosecution





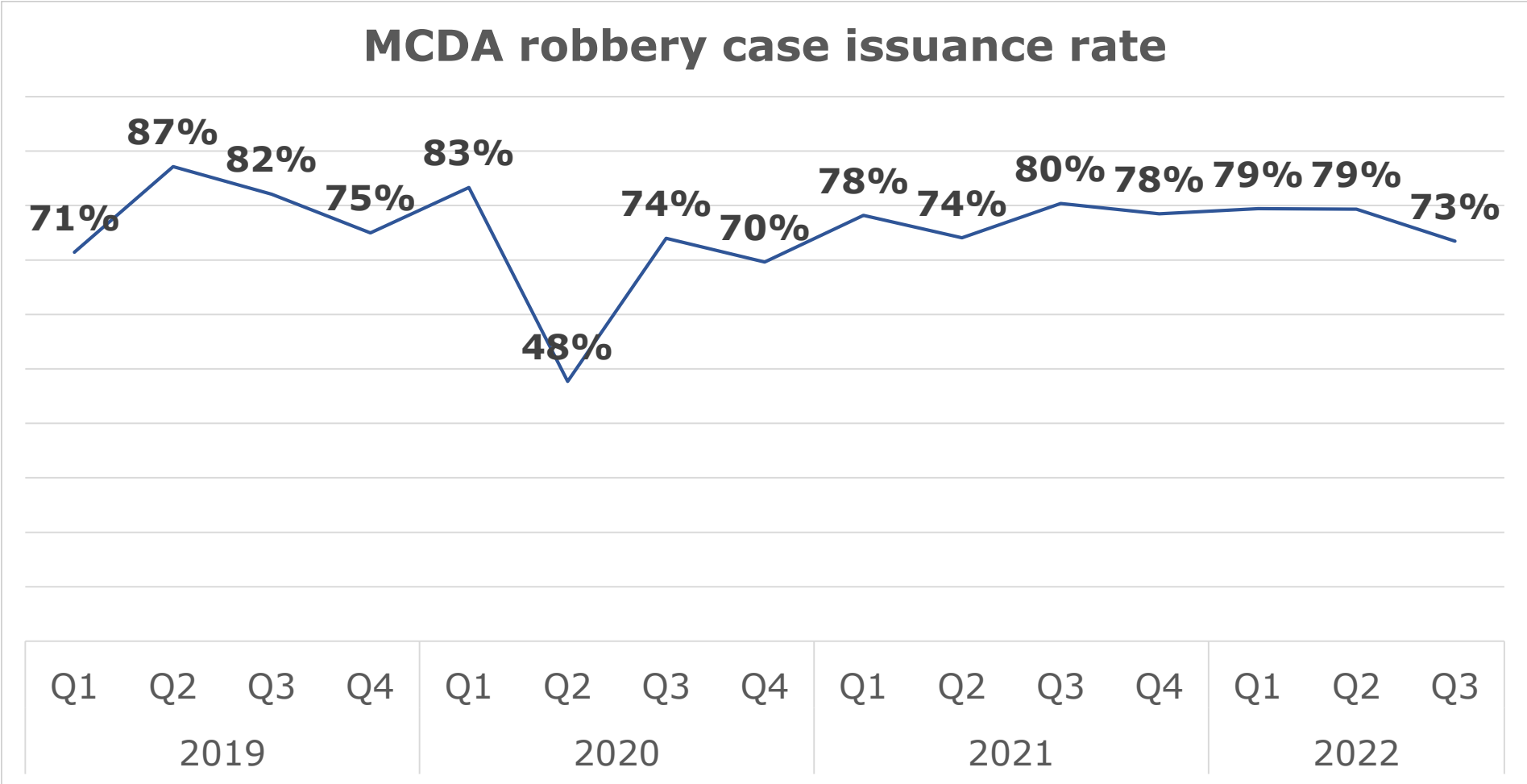
# Robbery clearance rate

**Percent of robberies reported to PPB resulting in cases referred to MCDA**



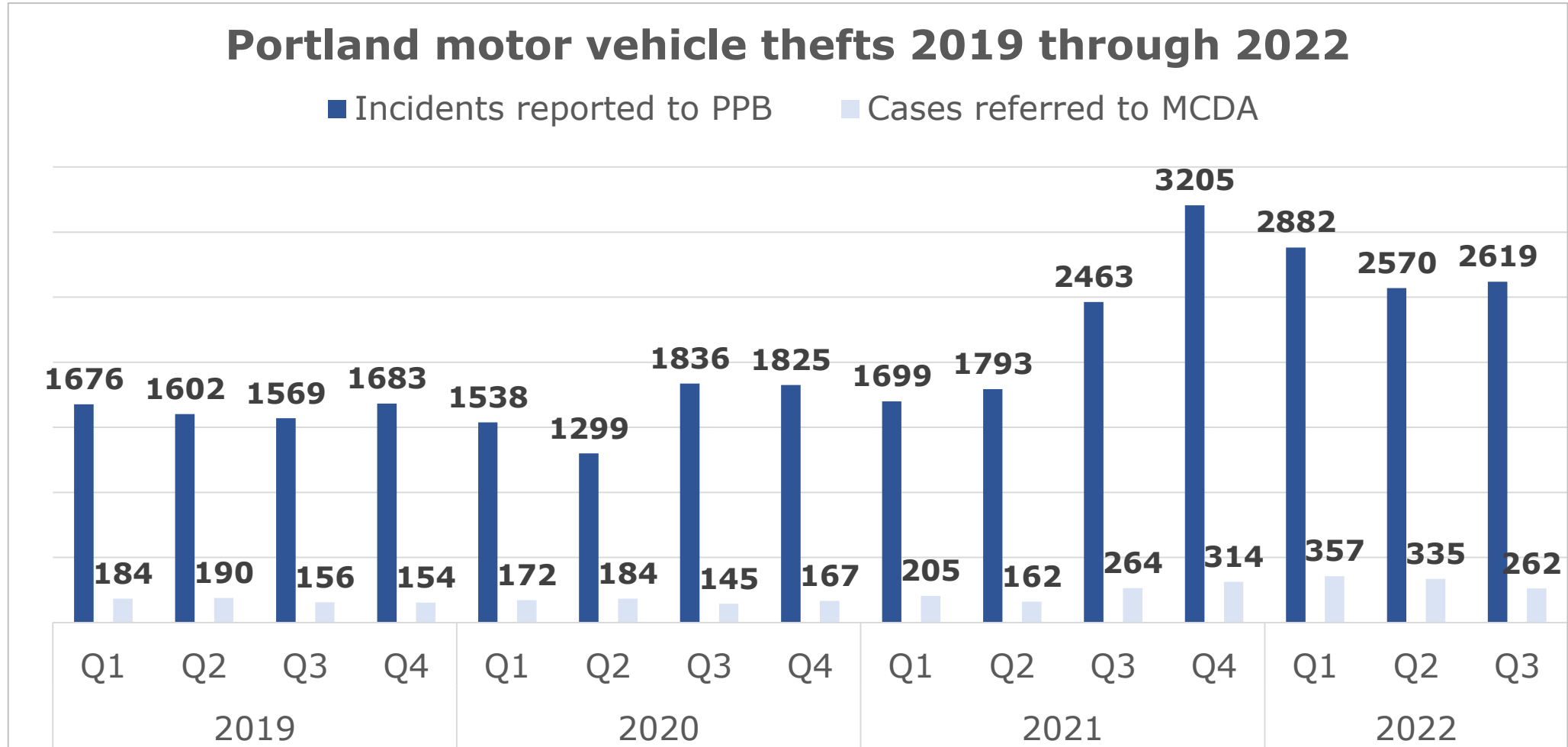

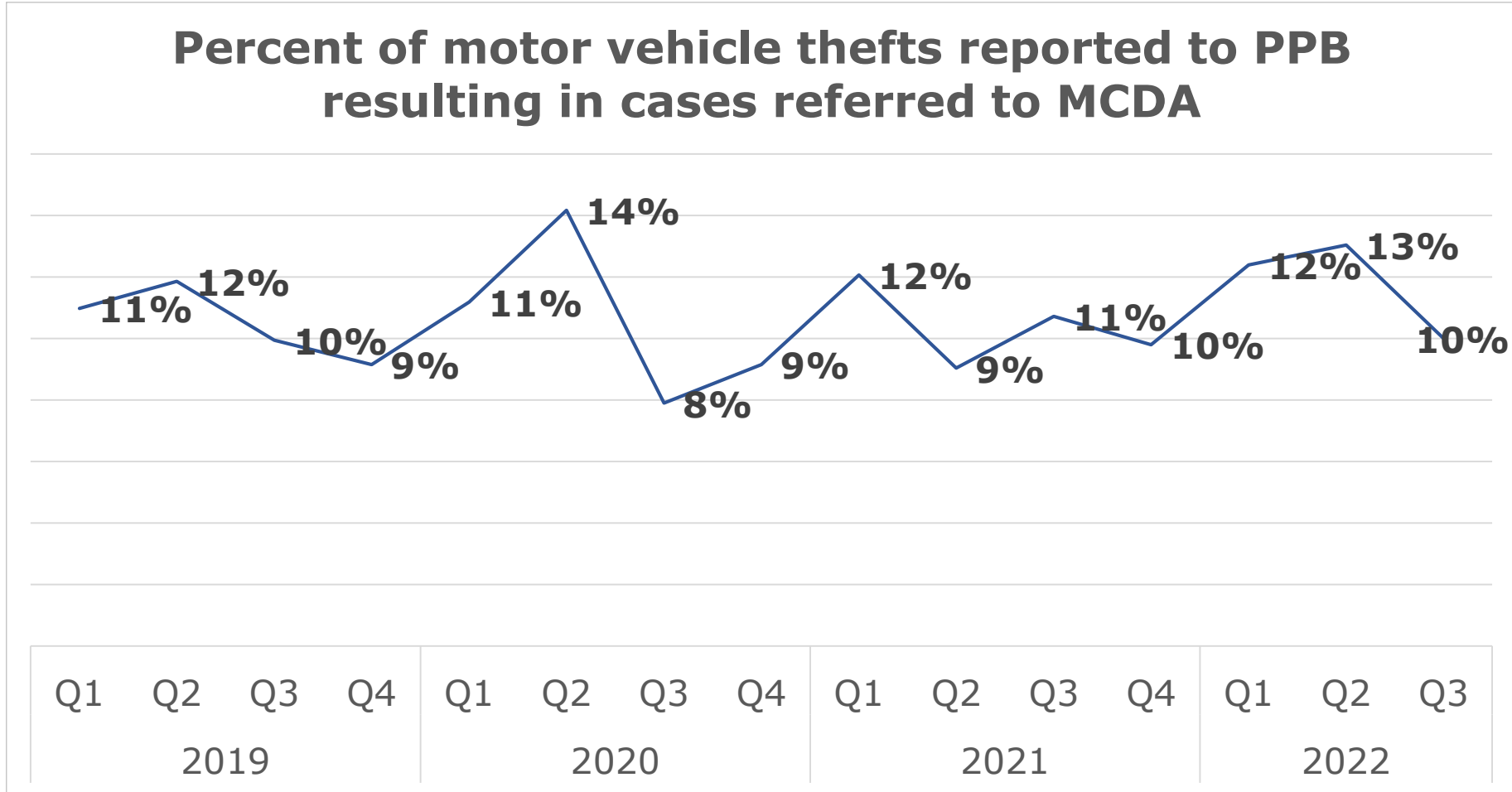

# Motor vehicle thefts reported vs. motor vehicle theft cases referred for prosecution



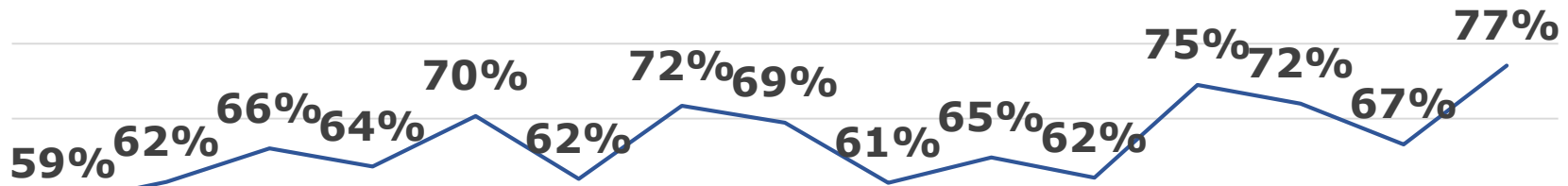
# Motor vehicle theft clearance rate

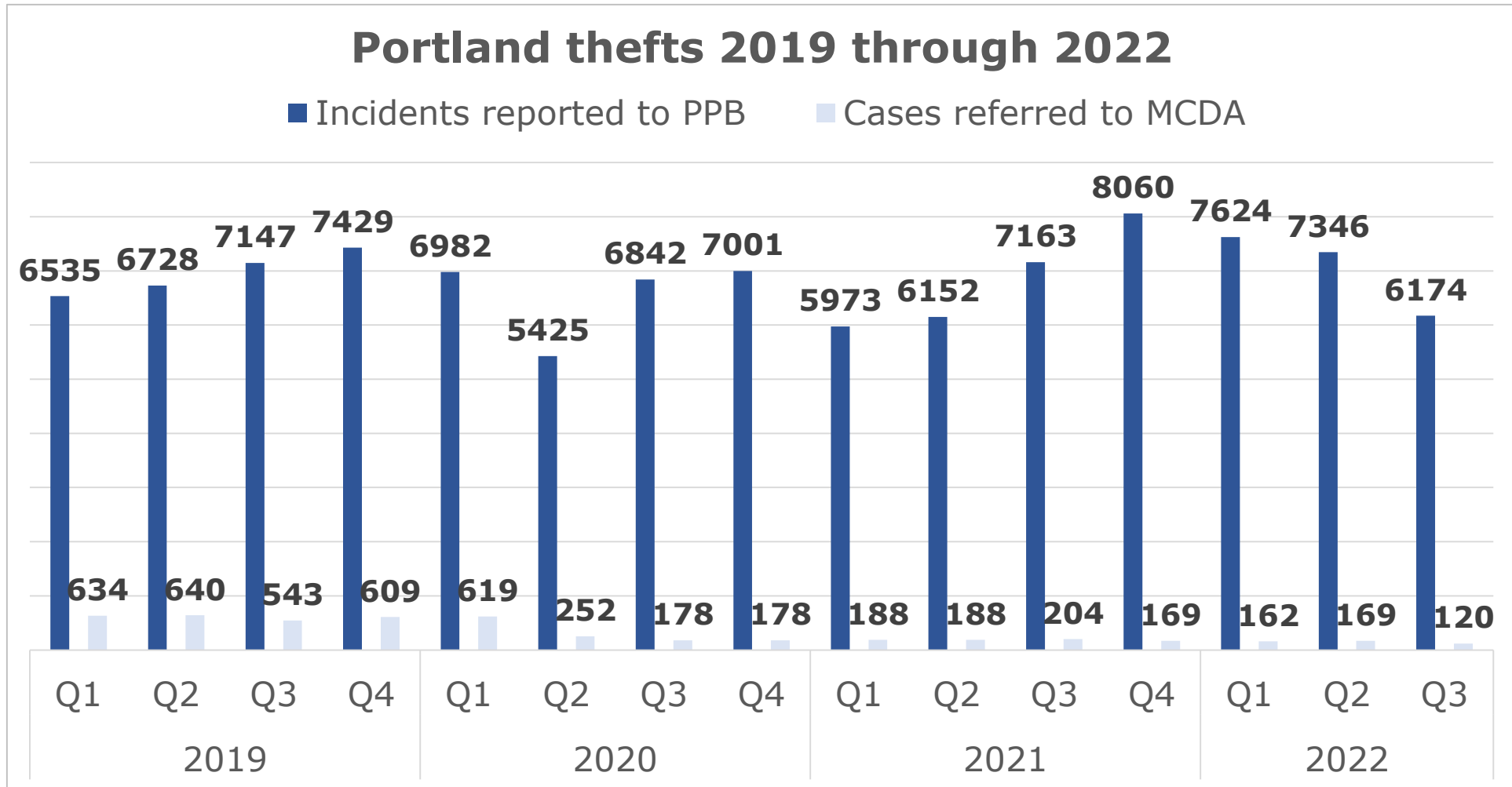

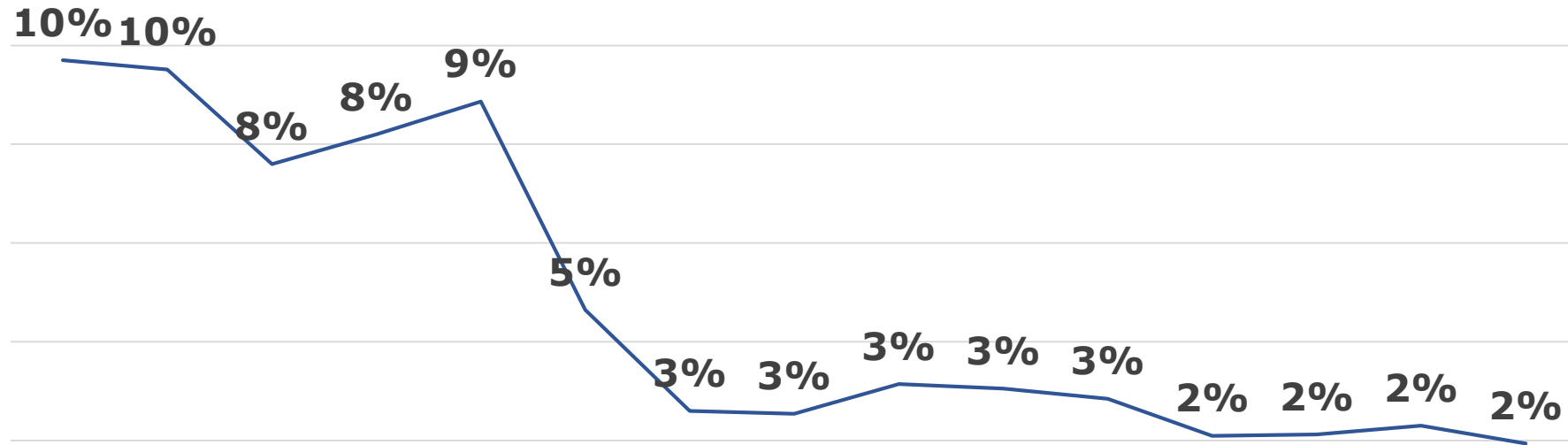
# Thefts reported vs. theft cases referred for prosecution





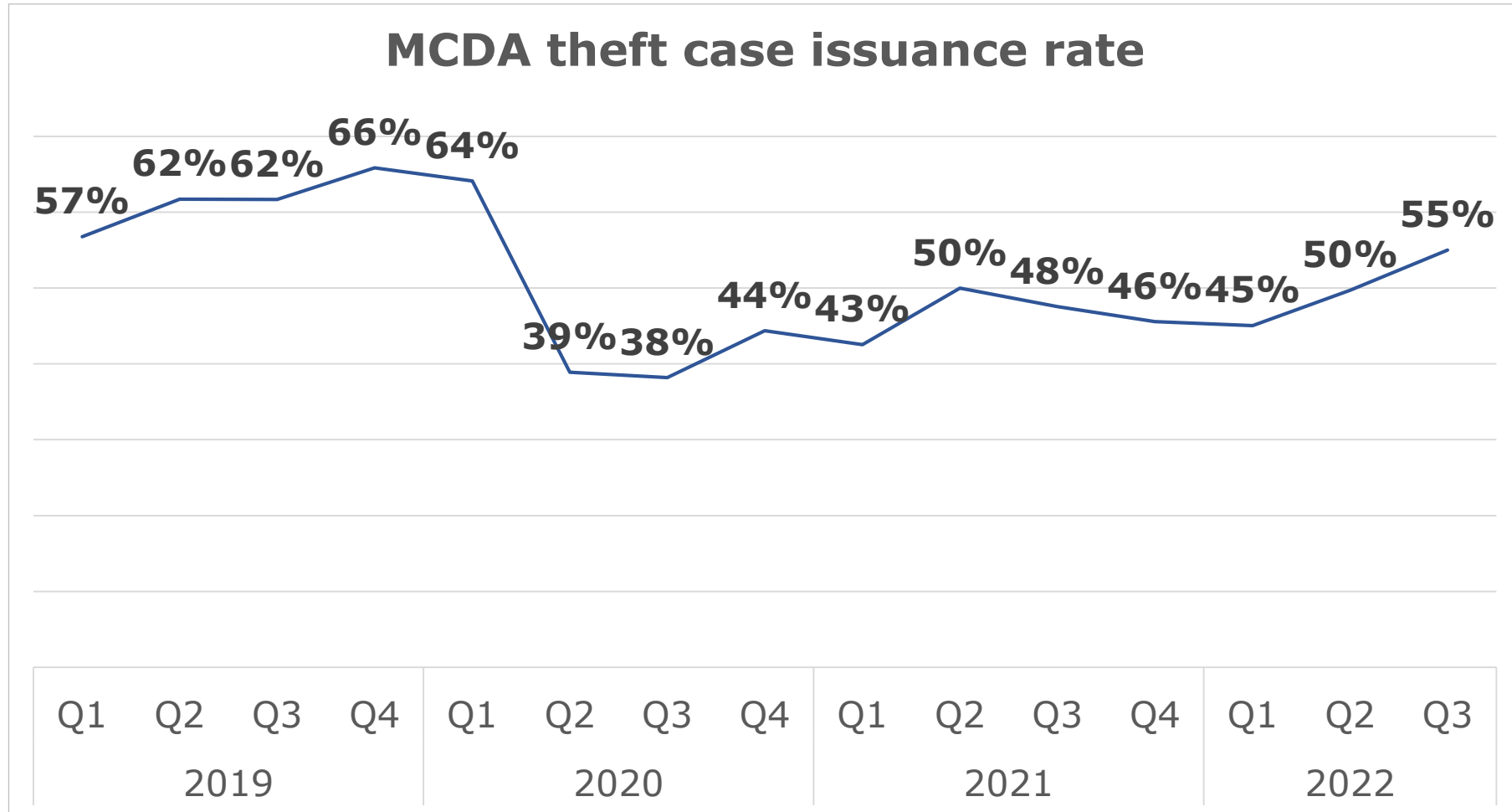
# Theft clearance rate

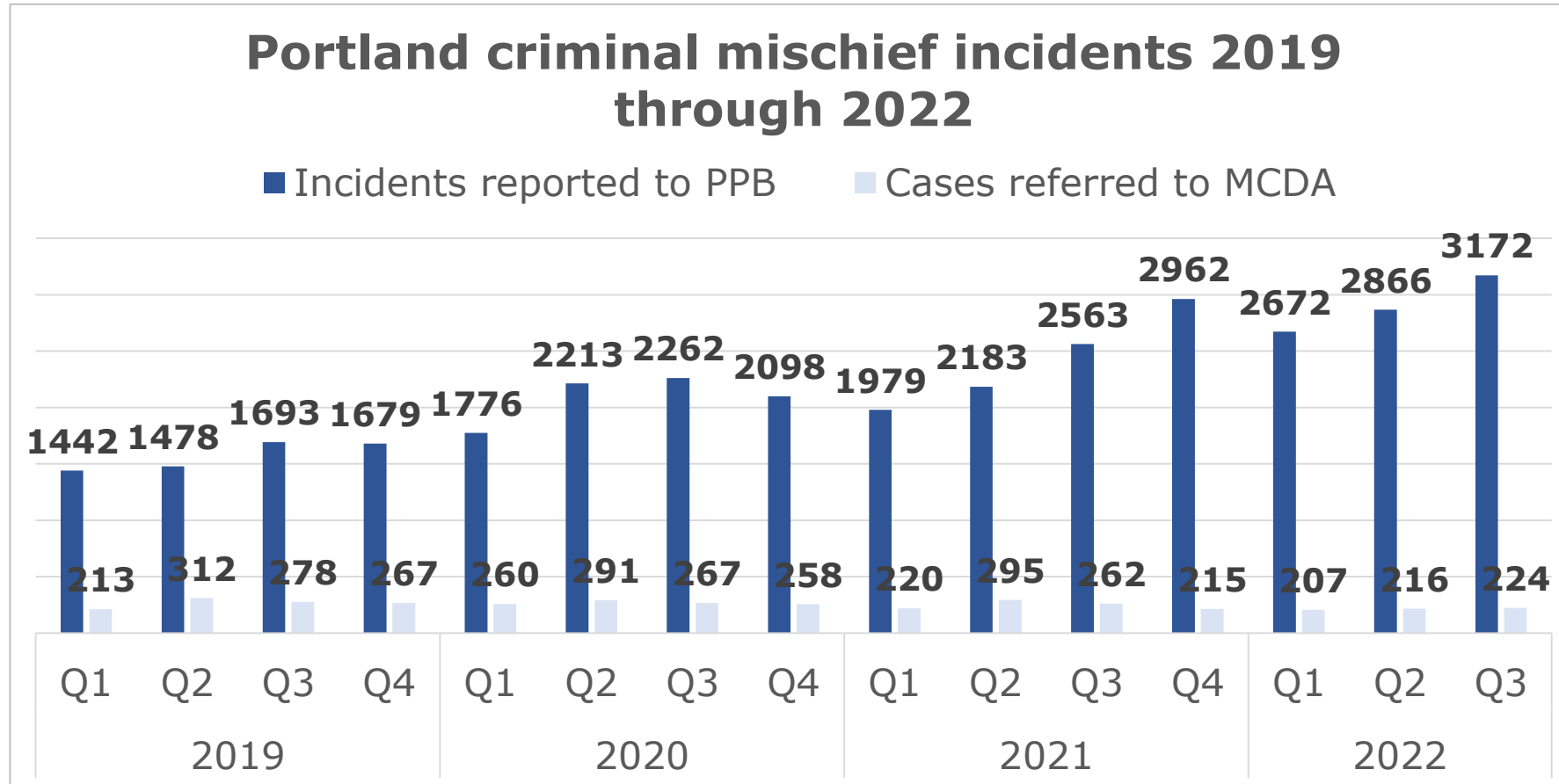

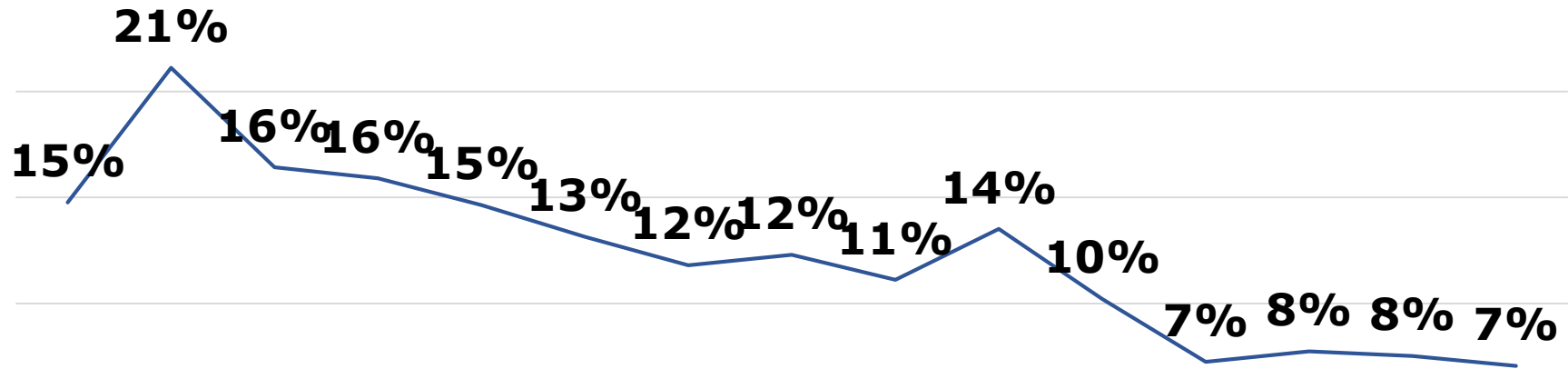
